

What's New at St Mary's This Year

God be praised for the blessings bestowed on the students, faculty, and staff of Saint Mary's Catholic School in this past academic year. We saw continued growth in our enrollment, substantial support for the Saint Mary's Gala and the Golf Classic, and continued improvement in our facilities and classroom technology.

Our \$7 million parish capital campaign continues, and thanks to the generous donations of our parish and school families, construction will soon begin on an expansion to our campus athletic facilities that will benefit both church and school. The new practice gym will first be used by the parish for daily and weekly mass during planned renovations to the church interior, and the new gym will also allow the school to expand our athletic offerings and serve as the host school for league and diocesan tournaments.

Our annual gala and golf tournament were an incredible success. Because of this success, we were able to purchase a new class set of iPads with a mobile charging and storage cart for our kindergarten classroom in honor of Mrs Adeline Garrison, former kindergarten teacher and school nurse at Saint Mary's Catholic School from

1963 to 1989. Over the summer, we were able to remove unused radiators from half our classrooms in Mercy Hall, opening a few extra feet of space for our teachers to utilize. And additional funds from these two projects will help with the construction of the new gym.

The 2021-2022 school year concluded with 322 students enrolled at Saint Mary's Catholic School, and the 2022-2023 school year began with a few more. This is an increase of over 20% from four years ago, and many of these students are able to attend Saint Mary's only because of the financial assistance provided by our Annual Fund. Over 10% of Saint Mary's students receive tuition or emergency assistance, and thanks to your donations, families facing financial hardship can remain at Saint Mary's School and continue to enjoy the benefits of a rigorous Catholic education.

The incredible growth we have experienced over the past five years is a testament to the strength of our Catholic identity, to the clarity of our school mission, to the quality of our academic, athletic and artistic programs, and to the talent and hard work of our entire faculty and staff. Most of our new parents discovered Saint Mary's from hearing about us directly from our long-time families and alumni, and we encourage you to continue to spread the good word about Greenville's oldest private school. We extend our deepest gratitude to everyone who is part of our school community, and we are truly grateful for your generous support which enables Saint Mary's Catholic School to fulfill our mission of providing the highest quality education rooted in Tradition, Virtue, and Excellence.


